MINUTES:

1. First Order of Business was the Events Report from Michaelle: Next gymnastics season, all competitors will be automatically signed up for meets. You will have to un-sign them up with Coach (Donna) 10 days in advance of scheduled meet.
2. Next order of business was the Fundraising Report by Shelli Miller. She will be sending out a fund raising report via e-mail weekly. We are in need of people to work the remaining Scope soccer games. We are in need of people for Harbor Park baseball game 23 April. We need 16 people for the Circus @ Scope 15 and 16 April. (Thu/Fri) We have 31 families in our TPA group with 5 families who have not met their points for the quarter.
3. Treasurers Report by Christie B:
There are six (6) calendars left; \$15 each. We have a loss of \$57.50 and we need to sell four more to break even.
There are three Value Check books left to be sold. Overall profit \$270.
The group has sold 37 Boxes of candy.
The Little Caesars Fundraiser made \$495.58 profit.
4. Cheer account has \$1017 in the General Fund; \$1582 in Parents Acct. The total for the Cheer Account is \$ 2599. Gymnastics has \$5370 in the General Acct and \$ 4462 in the Personal Accts for a combined total of \$9833.

5. The concessions from the Fun Meet netted a profit of \$100.75 and the flowers \$87.

TPA Director, Robin made a few comments regarding issues with our group: Be nice to the customers and keep a happy face when working our public event at Scope, etc. Her next concern was on parental sportsmanship; don't talk about other children negatively who participate in the meets if you don't have anything positive to say. Parents should not criticize the children, judges or the coaches. The situation is between the coach, child and the parent.

Christy motioned for the TPA to give \$205 and a \$25 gas card to pay other additional fees to the Coach associated with the Midlothian Gym Meet.
